IMPACT

- Our 'Impact' formats cover our inventory that you just can't miss. These locations are perfect for creating stand-out impact with big scale, reaching a large audience in high footfall locations. Formats include creative wall vinyls, banners and backlit lightboxes.
- Impact formats suit campaigns with a clear callto-action and bold creative who want to make an impact with their audience, directing them to a website or action.



DWELL

- 'Dwell' formats include inventory in locations where the audience are waiting around (e.g. check-in, security, immigration) and has the capacity to take time to digest advertising.
- This format fits campaigns who want their audience to dwell on their campaign a bit longer, perhaps you have some longer copy you'd like them to engage with or a more complex message to get across.

WORKING TOGETHER, THESE FORMATS ENABLE CLIENTS TO BUILD AWARENESS OF THE MESSAGE THROUGH HIGH IMPACT FORMATS AND THEN REINFORCE THAT MESSAGE WITH LONGER DWELL TIME FORMATS, WHEN THEY ARE IN THE RIGHT FRAME OF MIND TO ENGAGE.



Why use airport advertising?

Airport advertising in general, provides a unique opportunity for brands to engage with a captive and openly alert audience for longer periods of time.

Airport audiences cover a range of demographics; but as a whole they are **captivated** and **positive**.

The airport environment creates a positive experience for passengers, a location where "normal" rules don't apply and they don't adhere to the same considerations for need and price as they do in their everyday lives.

Many consider the airport part of the holiday experience, this provides brands with the opportunity to engage with their audience while they are in a receptive mood to advertising.

In addition to this, brands which advertise in airports are perceived as international and prestigious, boosting positive brand perception.

Why Cardiff Airport?

Cardiff Airport is predicted to manage 1 million passengers in 2023 with new daily flights to Paris just launched as well as additional capacity on TUI flights out of the country.

Despite lower passenger figures than previous years', the airport's passengers are a passionate and proud, predominantly Welsh group, making them unmissable for local and national brands looking to build reputation and affinity.

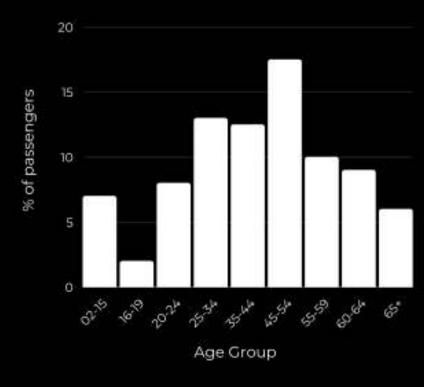

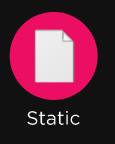




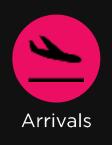
Static 96 Sheet.

This static 96-sheet is located outside the entrance to the airport, visible to all passengers departing and arriving as well as those using the passenger drop-off zone.











Digital 48 Sheet.

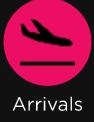
This eye-catching digital site is located outside both arrivals and departures lounges, and therefore appeals to 100% of airport traffic.

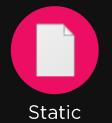




Static 6 Sheets.

Our network of static 6 sheets reaches passengers across the airport; from departures, duty free to security and arrivals. Achieve 100% share of voice with this eye-catching illuminated, static format.

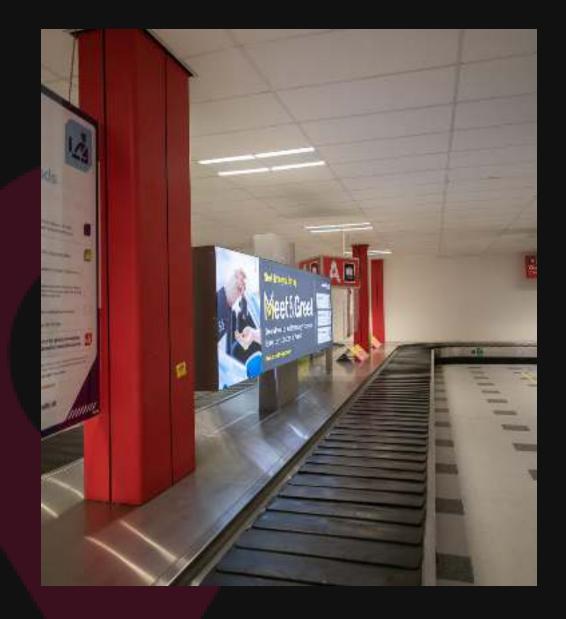


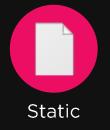


Baggage Reclaim Landscape Lightbox.

These formats work really well alongside the baggage trolleys.



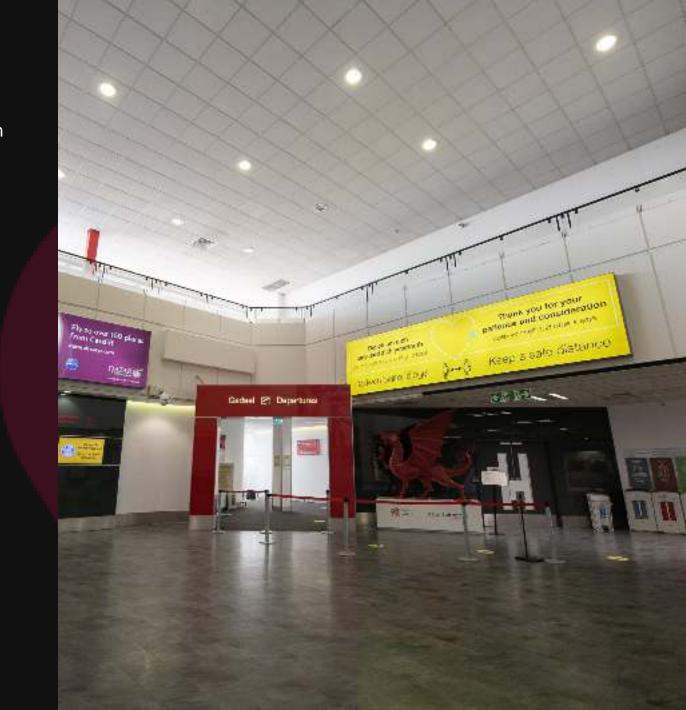


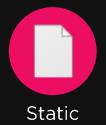




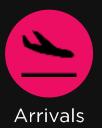
Lightboxes.

Impossible to miss and eye-catching, our illuminated lightboxes are located in high-dwell and footfall locations in departures, duty free and arrivals.





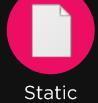


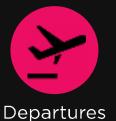


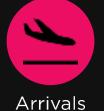
Bespoke.
